Players *given* a bye because a section has an odd no. of players, or because their opponent has failed to arrive in time, will receive a 1 point bye. In addition, every effort will be made to provide players with a graded game (although this will not count towards the tournament score).

Prize money will not be determined by tie-break, but will be shared among all eligible players.

The nearest train station is Ware.

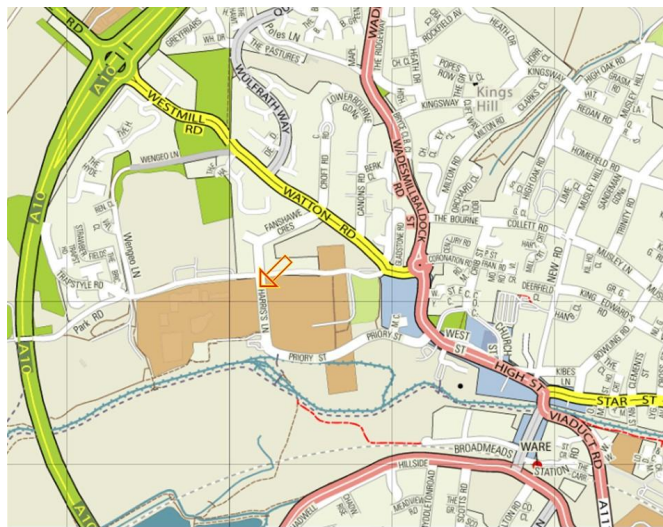

Map of Venue

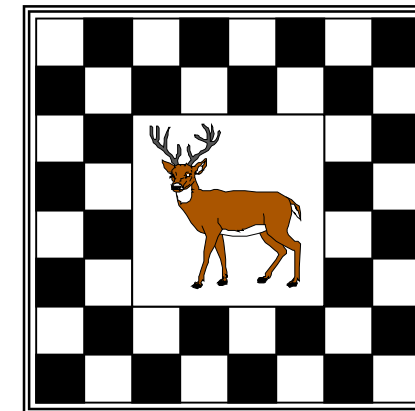
